## Directions to the Show

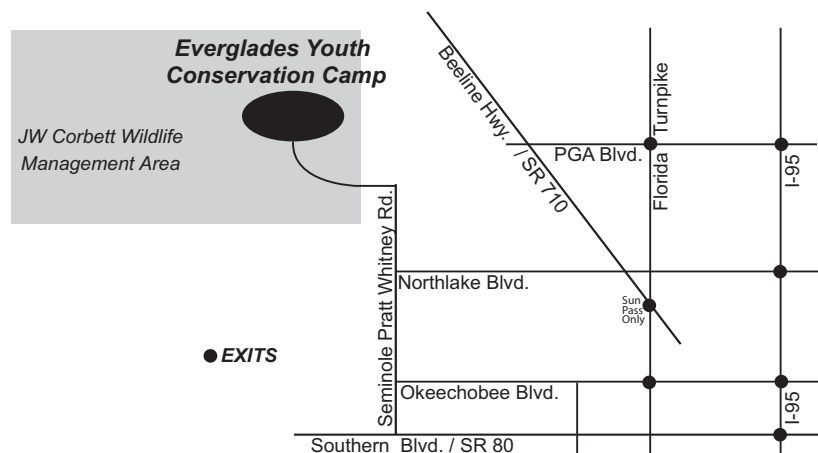
**From I-95:** Exit at Northlake Blvd. and travel west to Seminole Pratt Whitney Road. Turn right and travel three miles to J.W. Corbett Wildlife Management Area/Everglades Youth Conservation Camp. Turn left into area and follow signs.

**From the Turnpike (South):** Exit at Okeechobee Blvd. and travel west to Seminole Pratt Whitney Road. Turn right and continue on Seminole Pratt Whitney past Northlake Blvd. an additional three miles to the J.W. Corbett Wildlife Management Area/Everglades Youth Conservation Camp. Turn left into area and follow signs.

**From the Turnpike (North):** Exit at PGA Blvd. and travel west to SR 710 (Beeline Hwy.) Turn left and travel to Northlake Blvd. Turn right and travel west to Seminole Pratt Whitney (to the end), turn right and travel an additional three miles to the J.W. Corbett Wildlife Management Area/Everglades Youth Conservation Camp. Turn left into area and follow signs.

**From SR80:** Travel east/or west depending on your direction to Seminole Pratt Whitney Road. (A big red barn is on the corner). Turn north (you cannot turn any other direction) and travel on Seminole Pratt Whitney past Northlake Blvd. an additional three miles to the J.W. Corbett Wildlife Management Area/Everglades Youth Conservation Camp. Turn left into area and follow signs.

**From SR 70:** Travel east on SR70 to SR 710 (Beeline Hwy.) and turn right on SR 710 and travel southeast about 60 miles to Northlake Blvd. Turn right and travel west to Seminole Pratt Whitney Road (to the end), turn right and travel an additional three miles to the J.W. Corbett Wildlife Management Area/Everglades Youth Conservation Camp. Turn left into area and follow signs.
